A. Membership is limited to persons:

- 1.) Who reside in the State of Indiana or whose principal place of business is in the State.
- 2.) Who have appropriate educational background, and
- 3.) Whose usual professional activities relate primarily to environmental management, planning, impact assessment, environmental protection, or environmental compliance, including such activities as permitting, compliance auditing, regulatory review, research, teaching, engineering, design, quality assurance, health assessment and implementation of environmental protection and control. All members shall subscribe to the Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice, available through the INAEP board at the applicant's request.

B. All candidate applications must be approved by a majority of the INAEP Board of Directors upon the recommendation of one of the Association's Vice President, Secretary, Treasure, or membership committee, before membership is granted.

General Member: Persons who meet each of the requirements set forth in subsection A above and who have been engaged in such activities for not less than three (3) years shall be General members.

Student Member: Requires at least half-time registration in an academic course of study leading to a degree with a concentration in an environmentally-related field.

Associate Member: Persons who are, or actively seek to become, involved in environmental professional activities, but who do not meet the requirements for General membership may become Associate members.

Corporate or Institutional Membership. Persons within Corporate and or Institution must meet each of the requirements set forth in subsection A above. In addition, Corporate Membership includes the following:

- Membership benefits include 5 floating memberships, all of whom must adhere to the INAEP General or Associate Membership requirements and Environmental Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice of the INAEP; the floating membership may be varied persons within the company and will be determined by the company. The company takes responsibility to notify the INAEP Membership Chairman regarding employees who will have membership on behalf of the company;
- For each additional membership requested over the five floating memberships, a reduced membership fee of \$25 will be assessed to the company;
- Entitled to one vote on all matters put before the Association. The company must designate one representative for voting purposes and that member must meet the General Membership requirements;

- Dues: \$150 per year
